shall proceed to enforce the collection thereof as though the sections hereinbefore mentioned had not been repealed and re-enacted, and the present sheriff of said county shall have full power to enforce collection of all taxes which may be placed in his hands for collection before the first day of May, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, in the same manner as though the sections repealed and re-enacted by this act had not been repealed and re-enacted; provided, no levy hereafter to be made by the late or present sheriff for the enforcement Whendeem'd or payment of taxes shall be deemed valid, unless made upon the premises, and notice thereof with a copy of the tax-bill be served upon the party owing the taxes at least thirty days before advertisement of the property for sale, the said sheriff shall give the same and no more expensive notice of any sale than is hereinbefore provided to be given by the Treasurer, and he shall be entitled to the same fees as are hereinbefore prescribed for said Treasurer.

CHAPTER 495.
