

SEC. 9. The warden shall receive a salary at the rate of two thousand dollars per year, and shall be allowed subsistence, fuel, and the occupancy of such parts of the front buildings as a dwelling as are not used for purposes of the penitentiary, and all necessary out-houses, yards and grounds not within the walls of the prison proper, but shall receive no other pay, emoluments or perquisites for his services. Salary of Warden.
No other perquisites.

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay N. C. Robertson, Clerk of the Baltimore City Court, the costs and expenses in certain cases in which the State of Maryland was the plaintiff, and judgments rendered in favor of the defendants.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer, to pay N. C. Robertson, Clerk of the Baltimore City Court, three hundred and eighty-two dollars and fifteen cents, the costs and expenses due him as clerk in certain cases pending in the Baltimore City Court, in which the State of Maryland was the plaintiff, and judgments rendered therein in favor of the defendant. Comptroller directed to issue warrant.

SEC 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force
