

## CHAPTER 76.

AN act to repeal section two hundred and two of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore county," sub-title "Wild Fowls," and to repeal and re-enact section one hundred and ninety-eight of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore county," sub-title "Wild Fowls."

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and two of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore county," sub-title "Wild Fowl," be and the same is hereby repealed, and that section one hundred and ninety-eight of the said article three, entitled "Baltimore county," sub-title "Wild Fowl," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 198. If any person shall use any sink-boats, sneak-boats or floats, in any of the waters of Baltimore county, save and except the waters commonly called Spring Gardens, for the purpose of and while engaged in shooting at or killing wild ducks, or other wild fowl, each person engaged therein, directly or indirectly, shall be subject to a penalty or fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, and for shooting at or killing wild ducks or other wild fowl in any manner in the night time, each person engaged therein, either directly or indirectly, shall be subject to a penalty or fine of fifty dollars for the first offence, and not more than one hundred for every offence after the first, and any person or persons upon whom any of the said fines are imposed, in default of paying the same shall be committed to jail for not more than thirty days, or until discharged by due course of law for each offence ; and all things hereinafter enumerated found in the possession of any person or persons at the time of violating this section, shall be forfeited, that is to say, that all sink-boats, sneak-boats, crafts, floats and boats, the gun or guns, and all other property found in the possession of such person or per-
