

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Board of Public Works to build and equip three new sailing vessels for the State Fishery Force, and to sell the three old sloops now owned by said Force.

Which were severally read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Prince George's County," to be known as "Section 332."

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church of Frederick, Maryland, to sell and convey certain real estate in Frederick city.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

House bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 13, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Havre de Grace," relating to excavating or moulding-sand or otherwise, to come in after section 169, and to be called section 169 A, and to repeal all laws and parts of laws inconsistent therewith.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Robinson, Seibert and Rogers.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 31, Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Birds and Game."

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Washington county to issue bonds for building a school house in Cavetown.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 127, of Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fences;" and to re-enact with amendments.

Which were read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Seibert, Robinson and Moss.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 136 of Article 5, 182 of Article 9, and 112 of Article 19, of the Code of Public Local Laws, of the respective titles "Calvert County," "Charles County" and St. Mary's County," and
