Which was considered, and referred to the Committeee on Judicial Proceedings.

Mr. Seibert, from a Select Committe, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact section 236, of Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hancock."

With the following proposed amendment:

Strike out in line 7 the word "fifty," and insert "twenty-five."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to increase the salaries of the Judges of this State.

Was read the third time, and failed for want of a constitutional majority, by yeas and nays, as follows:
