Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the "Maryland Title, Insurance and Trust Company," incorporated by an Act of the General Assembly, passed at the January Session, 1884, chapter 425.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and delivered the following bills:

Hense bill entitled an Act to amend Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Crimes and Punishments," by adding a new subtitle to be known as "Fawdy Houses and Houses of Ill-Fame," and add a new section to be known as section $16~\Lambda$.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery," sub-title "Pleading, Practice, and Process." to be designated section A.

House bill entitled an Act to protect persons keeping boarders and lodgers in their houses.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 160, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments."

Which were severally read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and amend section 49, of Article 25, of the Code of Public General Laws, sub-title "Draining Land."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Labor.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," to be designated as section 39 A.

House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Patapsco Title Company of Baltimore city.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
