

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Article 1, of section 4, of chapter 169, of the Acts of 1878, entitled an Act to continue the corporate existence of the President, Directors and Company of the Hagerstown Bank, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter 400, of the Acts of 1886, entitled an Act to authorize the Board of Managers of the Maryland Hospital for the Insane to sell certain land lying between the Catonsville Short Line Railroad and the Frederick Turnpike.

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Patapsco Title Company of Baltimore city, Maryland.

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Somerset county to levy for and pay the Judges of the Orphans' Court the same mileage allowed County Commissioners by the Code of Public General Laws.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Writing Telegraph Company of Baltimore city, a corporation incorporated under the General Laws of this State.

Senate bill entitled an Act to enable George W. Long, collector of Somerset county for the year 1888, to enforce the payment of taxes not heretofore collected by him.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 155, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Carroll County," sub-title "Taneytown."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 6, 18 and 25, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Public Education."

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the F. C. and H. S. Todd Company.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal certain sections of Article 20, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Somerset County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and sub-title "Revenue and Taxes," and to enact other sections in lieu thereof, respecting the term of office and powers of the County Commissioners.
