Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 171, 172, 173, 176, 178, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Justices of the Peace," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add new sections to said Article.

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In section B, line 39, after "P. M.," insert the words "and from seven o'clock P. M., to ten o'clock, P. M."

Amend section 178 A, by striking out all of said section after the word "except," in line 103, and insert "he shall be allowed the sum of twenty-five dollars per month by the Mayor, Counselor and Aldermen of the city of Annapolis for services rendered in cases for violation of the Code of said city."

In line 126, strike out the word "forty" and insert "fifty," also in line 130, strike out the word "forty" and insert the word "fifty"
