ORDER OF THE DAY.

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the words "a bill entitled," and in insert as follows:

"An Act to add a new section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," under the new sub-title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," to come in said Article alphabetically, in proper place, to be designated as "Section 120 X."

"Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and the same is hereby added to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," under the new sub-title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," to be located as to its proper alphabetical place in said Article, to be designated as 'Section 120 X,' and to read as follows:
