

House bill entitled an Act for the regulation of the sale of opium, cocaine and chloral in any form.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Baltimore City Senators.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to make a special levy in the village of Mt. Washington, &c.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Hubner, Brown and Bennett.

House bill entitled an Act granting the consent of the State of Maryland to the acquisition by the United States, or by States, &c., to erect monuments commemorative of the battles of Antietam and Monocacy.

House bill entitled an Act ceding to the United States of America jurisdiction, over certain property acquired by it for the use of Government Hospital for Insane.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Federal Relations.

House bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 72, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Oysters," sub-title "State Fishery Force," providing additional boats for the State Fishery Force.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries.

House bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 23, Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Department."

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Cumberland Valley Railroad Company to connect with the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal at or near Powell's Bend, where its railroad bridge crosses said canal and the Potomac river.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 8 and 11, of Article 23, Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations."

House bill entitled an Act to amend Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," by adding a new section, to be designated 167 A.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
