

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the separate codification of the statute and common law, defining the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace and the offences cognizable by said Justices, with the respective penalties thereto attached.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 12, of Article 56, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Stock Brokers."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 9, of Article 52, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Justices of the Peace," sub-title "Civil Jurisdiction."

House bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Fraud by Drivers of Cabs."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 25, of Article 47, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Insolvents."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 77, of Article 5, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Appeals," sub-title "Appeals in Criminal Cases."

Which were severally read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Board of Public Works to sell the Eastern Hay Scales of Baltimore and to purchase a more eligible site for the same.

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the payment by the State for certain debts contracted by the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company during 1887, 1888, 1889 and 1890, for labor and raw materials and for the assignment of the same to the State.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor to appoint delegates to the National Road Congress of the several States of the Union to be held at Pittsburg, Pa., and to appropriate a sum of money to defray expenses of said delegates.

House bill entitled an Act to regulate the business of money lending on chattel mortgages and bills of sale by chattel brokers.
