Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit pool selling, &c., in Prince George's and Montgomery counties.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 2, of chapter 202, of the Acts of 1890, entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay for land that may be required to extend the Maryland Penitentiary, &c.

Senate bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 4, Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub title "Sheriff's Fees," to be designated as "Section 799 A."

Senate bill entitled an Act to create a commission to inquire into the distribution of the State School Tax and report to the next General Assembly.

Senate bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money for repairing the Executive Mansion.

· Senate bill entitled an Act to incoporate the Edmunson Avenue, Catonsville and Ellicott City Railway Company.

Senate bill entitled an Act to empower the Judges of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county to purchase law books for its Public Law Library and and to provide for payment of same.
