Favorable report from a majority of the Committee on Judicial Proceedings on Senate bill, printed, No. 98.

The above bill was originally referred to the Committee on Finance and by that Committee on the 25th of March reported to the Senate with the recommendation that the bill be referred to this Committee.

We find that the bill has been carefully drawn, and that it is not obnoxious to any legal or Constitutional objection. The full and free exercise of the right of appointment and removal is not impaired.
