"Entitled an Act to grant additional powers to the Cumberland Loan and Saving Association.

"Section 1. Beitenacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That in case the Board of Directors of the Cumberland Loan and Saving Association, a corporation duly organized and incorporated under the general incorporation law of this State, shall be in doubt whether the mortgage security taken from or offered by any member for the redemption of shares held by such member, is an ample and sufficient security for said purpose, such association shall have power to receive and take from such member a bond of indemnity
