Mr. Gorter submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out the word "three," in line 12 of said bill, and insert in lieu thereof the word "twelve," and add to the end of section 9 the words: "Provided that in the city of Baltimore the said suits may be brought within three months from the date of such letters."

Which was read and adopted, and said bill read the second time, and

On motion by Mr. Gorter,

The rules were suspended, so as to give a third reading to said bill this day, by yeas and nays as follows:
