Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact sections 214 and 214 A, Article 2, Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Sheriff," and to add a new section to said Article, to follow section 214 A, to be designated section 214 A.

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the speedy execution and enforcement of chapter 299, of the General Assembly of 1890, relating to the establishing and maintaining a High School in Centreville, Queen Anne's county.

Senate bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money for the support of the Home for Mothers and Infants of Baltimore city.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 337, of Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Clarksburg, in Montgomery county.

Senate bill entitled an Act authorizing and directing the Attorney-General to furnish certain information in regard to the property purchased by the province of Maryland in 1755, known as "Fort Frederick."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 234, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Receiving Stolen Goods, &c."
