

## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend the title of the bill by inserting after the word "Wills," at the end of the second line thereof, the words following, to wit, as amended by an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1890, chapter 416, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections three hundred and thirty-one, and three hundred and thirty-four, of Article ninety-three, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Wills," and also by inserting after the word "Wills," in the second line of section 1, the following words, to-wit, as amended by an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, of 1890, chapter 416, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections three hundred and thirty-one, and three hundred and thirty-four, of Article ninety three, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Wills."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
