

REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Moss, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senat bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 185 and 186, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Orphans' Court," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
