House Joint Resolution requesting and directing the Senators and Representatives of the State of Maryland, in the Congress of the United States, to use their best efforts to secure the passage of a bill, having for its object the transfer of the Revenue Marine Service from the Treasury Department to the Navy Department of the United States.
