House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 95, of Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Elections," sub-title "Contested Elections," and to re-enact the same with amendments, an additional section to said Article, to follow after section 95, to be known as "Section 95 A," and to further regulate the trial of contested elections in the counties of this State.
