## INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

Senate bill entitled an Act to add sections to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "False Pretenses," relating to frauds and false pretenses against hotel keepers.

Senate bill entitled an Act to add new sections to Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Telegraph Companies," to regulate the rental and use of telephones in the cities, towns and villages in the State of Maryland.
