Which were read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Waters, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to enable George W. Long, Collector of State and county taxes of Somerset county, for the year 1888, to enforce the payment of the taxes not heretofore collected by him.

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
