

House bill entitled an Act to amend section 810, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Streets, Bridges and Highways."

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," to be known as "Section 173 F," providing for the practice in certain cases in the Baltimore City Court.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 367, of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Harbor, Docks and Wharves," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4 of the Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," to be known as "Section 806 A," providing for the payment of money into court under condemnation proceedings in certain cases.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Baltimore City Senators.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 44 of Article 14, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "County Commissioners and Collectors," and to add additional sections thereto.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Rogers, Hubner and Moss.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester county to borrow money on the credit of the county for the purpose of bridges.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Austin, Dawson and Smith.

House bill entitled an Act to amend section 23, of Article 21, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Birds and Game."

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to grant a pension to John Q. Jones, of the second election district of said county.
