House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 12, of Article 48, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Inspections," sub-title "Tobacco."

Mr. Coffin, submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In line 32, after the word "warehouses," "provided that in the event of any of the tobacco warehouses having to procure additinal storage that any tobacco warehouse rented by the State for storage purposes shall accept all Maryland tobacco upon the same terms as now provided for by law.

Pending its consideration,

Mr. Wilkinson moved that said bill be indefinitely postponed.
