House bill entitled an Act to provide for the trial by the Justice of the Peace of Election District No. 2, in Frederick county, of persons charged with violating any of the ordinances of the Mayor and Aldermen of Frederick county.

BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS—THIRD READING.

Senate bill entitled an Act providing that the direct war tax levied by the United States upon the State of Maryland, and paid by the State of Maryland to the United States, and recently refunded by the United States to the State of Maryland, shall be credited to the Defence Redemption Loan of the State of Maryland, and invested for said loan in such securities as are provided by law for the investment of the securities of the Sinking Fund.
