

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 657 of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Licenses," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Baltimore City Senators.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 1, and to repeal section 11, of chapter 183, of the Laws of Maryland, passed at the Session of 1890, entitled "An Act to create a Treasurer for Calvert county, and to provide for the Collection of Taxss therein."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Moss, Posey and Brown.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section one, of chapter 589, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January Session, 1890, entitled an Act to protect birds and game and prevent trespassing with dog or gun on private property in Somerset county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Waters, Toadvin and Smith.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 121, of the Acts 1890, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Prince George's county to issue bonds, &c., and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Coffin, Seibert and Robinson.

House bill entitled an Act supplemental to an Act passed at the January Session, 1890, of the General Assembly of Maryland, chapter 130, entitled an Act to provide for the purchase or construction of water works for the town of Frostburg, in Allegany county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Pearre, Wilkinson and Hubner.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 16, of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Carroll County," sub-title "Circuit Court," as amended by chapter 136, of the Acts of 1890, and to add a sub-section thereto, to be designated "Section 16 A," providing for the drawing of jurors.
