

Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Pearre submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 1, line 10, after the words "in favor of," insert the following: "The Third National Bank of Cumberland, assignor of."

In section 1, line 12, after the words "in favor of," insert the following: "The Third National Bank of Cumberland, assignor of."
