

House bill entitled an Act to amend Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Commissioners of Pharmacy and Practical Chemistry."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 573, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore City," sub-title "Jail."

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Licenses," to be known as section 664 A.

House bill entitled an Act to enable the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to accept the transfer of the city's 6 per cent. stock in which the Peabody Institute fund is now invested, and in consideration thereof to issue other stock to an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars to said fund.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore to purchase or lease ground in the 21st and 22d wards of said city, and to have erected thereon a suitable station house or station houses.

House bill entitled an Act to amend the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown."

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Baltimore City Senators.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Washington County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to be known as section 117 A.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Seibert, Newman and Rogers.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford county to grant a pension to Bridget O'Donnell, widow of Matthew O'Donnell, of said county.
