

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 16, chapter 234, passed at January Session, 1890, entitled an Act to regulate the sale and granting of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in Baltimore county.

House bill entitled an Act to legalize and make valid two books, entitled "Plats No. 1 and Plats No. 2," respectively, in the Clerk's office of the Circuit Court of Baltimore county.

Which were read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Hubner, Robinson and Moss.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Caroline county to appoint an additional Constable for the First Election District of Caroline county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Dawson, Brown and Austin.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Alleghany County," sub-title "Collector."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Pearre, Getty and Seibert.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 214, of Article 12, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Sheep."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Getty, Pearre and Waters.

House Bill entitled an Act to authorize the Burgess and Commissioners of Middletown, Frederick county, Maryland, to issue bonds for the purpose of constructing, operating and keeping in repair water works for said town.

House bill entitled an Act to amend an Act entitled an Act, incorporating the Baltimore College of Dental Surgery, passed Feb. 1st, 1840, chapter 155, as amended by an Act passed 1870, chapter 149.
