Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 2, of Article 45, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Husband and Wife," as the same was enacted by chapter 394 of the Acts of Assembly of 1890, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 32, of Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Administration."

And with the further report that

These two bills "are to be taken and considered together as a whole; it would not be proper to enact one into a law without enacting the other into a law also."

Senate bill entitled an Act to regulate the practice of medicine and surgery in Maryland, for non-resident practitioners.
