And, returned, the following bills:

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Annapolis, Eastport and Bay Ridge Electric Rail and Power Company of Anne Arundel county.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 185 and 186, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Orphans' Court," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to empower the State's Attorney for Baltimore county, upon order of the Circuit Court for said county, to file criminal information.

Senate bill entitled an Act to add sections to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Inspections and Measures, Live Stock," relating to the sale or lease of the State Cattle Yards.

Severally endorsed: "Passed by year and nays."
