The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and delivered the following bills:

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money for the support of the Co operative Workers of Baltimore city.

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay to the Treasurer of the State Board of Education the amount of sundry bills paid by him for repairs to the State Normal School building.

House bill entitled an Act to amend Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Corporations," sub-title "Turnpike, Plank Road and Passenger: ailway Companies," by adding a new section thereto, to be known as "Section 236 A."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H and K, of Article (2), of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Somerset County," sub-title "Oysters," as the same appears in chapter 269 of the Acts of 1890.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Waters, Dawson and Getty.
