House bill entitled an Act to add three additional sections to the Act passed at January Session, 1890, chapter 334, entitled an Act to regulate the sale and granting of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in Baltimore county.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Hubner, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to regulate the county printing in Baltimore county.

With the following proposed amendments:

Section 1, line 6, strike out the word "shall" and insert the word "may" in lieu thereof.

Which was adopted.

Said bill was then read the third time, and passed
