

And, favorably,

Ordered, That the State Printer print and bind in paper covers 500 copies of majority and minority reports of the constitutionality of the increase in the Judge's salaries, provided the cost does not exceed the sum of \$90.

With the following proposed amendments.

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Add after the end of order the following words: "and provided, that the price paid for the same shall be the price prescribed in the Code, and the binding to be a fair market price, all of which shall be ascertained by the Finance Committee, and its endorsement and approval shall be necessary to the payment for said work.
