House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 233, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Rape," and chapter 410, of the Acts of Assembly of 1890, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Amend section 233, in the second line thereof, by inserting after the word "or," and before the words "any woman," the additional words "knowingly, carnally, know and abuse."
