AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend section 1 by inserting in line 87, after the words "so marked," the following: "Unless the voter by the erasure of one or more names in the column or group, of which he has marked the party emblem or party name, shall have indicated for which of said candidates in the party column so marked he does not desire to vote, in this event the vote shall be counted for all the candidates under the party emblem or party names so marked, except the name or names
