

“And the said books, blanks and schedules so made, prepared and ruled, as to show separately the different values of personal property, real property, and under one head bonds, stocks and other private securities in the basis of taxation, and the State Tax Commissioner is specially charged with the enforcement of this requirement.”

Which was adopted.

Mr. Hayes submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 180, line 4, strike out “excepting,” and insert in lieu thereof “and.”

In same section, line 3, after the word “except,” insert “that in.”

In same section line 5, after the word “of,” insert “in” in lieu thereof.

In same section, line 3, before “county and except,” insert “bracket,” and in line 7, after ninety-two, insert “bracket.”

Which was adopted.

Mr. Wirt submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

“Provided, that this Act shall not apply to the assessment and collection of State, county and city taxes levied for the year 1892.”
