House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Washington county to refund to Martin L. Byers and others certain moneys paid by them as endorsers for George W. Pole, late Collector of State and county taxes.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 124, of Article 23, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Roads."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 41 to 47, inclusive, of Article 23, of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Fences."
