

“And the occupants of lots located under the sections hereby repealed, shall have such protection for their rights in said lots as is now provided for the occupants of lots located under Article 72, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, by section 41 of said Article, until the expiration of the time given and fixed by this section.”

Which were adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time.
