House bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Roads," to follow after section 177, and to be numbered 177 A.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal certain sections of the Code of Public Loca! Laws, Article 20, title "Somerset County," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Council of Brunswick, Frederick county, to issue improvement bonds to an amount not exceeding the sum of twenty thousand dollars.
