House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Charles county to levy a certain sum of money to pay H. Clagett Page of said county for indexing the Land Records of said county.

Which were read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Posey, Hubner and Brown.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace for the First Election District of Cecil county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Wirt, Wootton and Hepbron.

House bill entitled an Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Carroll county to refund to the Westminster Water Company taxes improperly paid by said company.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Bennett, Rogers and Hubner.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 14, of Article 25, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," so far as the same relates to Talbot county, and to repeal section 31, of Article 21, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "County Commissioners' Compensation," and to re-enact the last named section with amendments so as to fix the terms and compensation of the County Commissioners of said county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Lloyd, Brown and Dawson.

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the numbers and terms of the County Commissioners of Washington county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Seibert, Newman and Moss.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact section 56 and 57, of Article 24, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "Birds and Game."
