House bill entitled an Act to regulate the sale and the granting of license for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in Carroll county.

House bill entitled an Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors in School District No. 5, Election District No. 9, of Worcester county.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Temperance.
