House bill entitled an Act to add additional scetions to Article 56, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licences," sub-title "Penalties," to be designated as "Sections 89 B and 89 C," relating to obtaining liquors by minors and giving liquors to minors.

House bill entitled an Act to enable the University Club of Baltimore to issue bonds for the purchase and improvement of its club building.
