House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments new section 130, of Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," as enacted by the Act of 1890.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and delivered the following bills:

House bill entitled an Act to legalize and make valid the appointment of registers of voters and the boards of supervisors of elections in the city of Hagerstown, and the entries made, acts done and proceedings taken by said registers of voters in contemplated pursuance of the duties required of them, respectively, by chapter 36, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session, 1892.

House bill entitled an Act authorizing the transcribing of certain indexes of records and will books in the office of the Register of Wills of Washington county.

Which were read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Seibert, Newman and Robinson.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 156 and 169, of Article 24, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "Ocean City."

House bill entitled an Act to add a further supplement to the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the December Session, 1840, chapter 215, en-
