House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Walkersville, in Frederick county, Maryland.

House bill entitled an Act to enlarge and define the taxable limits of Frederick City, and to establish certain avenues, streets, and the boulevard as at present located, to fix the grade and macadamize the same.

House bill entitled an Act to amend section 258, of Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, relating to the lien of livery stable keepers in "Frederick City."

House bill entitled an Act to add two new sections to Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Calvert County," under the sub title "County Commissions," relating to the term of County Commissioners of said county.

House bill entitled an Act to carry into effect section 1, of Article 7, of the Constitution of this State, so far as the same relates to Howard county, and to repeal section 39, of Article 14, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "County Commissioners and County Collectors," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
