Add additional section known as "Section 14."

Section 14. And be it it enacted that the Baltimore and Towson Surbuban Railway Company shall first obtain the consent of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore city before work is commenced on said road, located within the limits of Baltimore city, upon such terms and conditions as the said Mayor and City Council may prescribe, and the said Railway Company shall first obtain the consent of the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, for the use of any of the public roads of said county.

Make section 14 section 15.

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Chesapeake Bank and enlarging its corporate powers and franchises, and changing its name to the Chesapeake Bank and Trust Company.
