House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford county to levy annually a sum of money for the relief of Adelia A. Crawley of said county.

Mr. Seibert, from a Select Committee, reported favorably, the following bills:

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the number and terms of the County Commissioners of Washington county.

House bill entitled an Act authorizing the transcribing certain indexes of records and will books in the office of Register of Wills for Washington county, Maryland.

House bill entitled an Act to legalize and make valid the appointment of Registers of Voters and the Board of Supervisors of Elections in the City of Hagerstown, and the entries made, acts done and proceedings taken by said Registers of Voters.

Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit fast driving or riding on or over the Highway bridge across the Potomac river, at Hancock, Maryland, of the Hancock Bridge Company of Washington county.
