### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

Senate bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Fish, Crabs and Terrapins," to follow immediately after section 159, and to be designated as section 159 A.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 106, of Article 56, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Public Education," sub-title "Sources of Income."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact section 217, of Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Religious Corporations."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact section 15, of chapter 598, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1890, entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Loan, Trust, Security and Insurance Company of Harford county, and to enlarge its powers, and to add a new section to said chapter, to be numbered section 16.
