House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 16, of Article 54, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Land Office," relating to the indexing of certain land records and extracts of deeds.

House bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 56, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Penalties," to be known as "Sections 89 B and 89 C," relating to obtaining liquors by minors.
