

District, to be known as 'Taylor's Island Precinct,' and that it shall consist of all that part of said Parson's Creek District lying to the westward of a line beginning at the headwaters of Parson's Creek and running with Stewart's Canal to its intersection with the headwaters of Blackwater River, and thence with said river to the Big Black Water Bridge, and the voting place of said Taylor's Island Precinct shall be at Taylor's Island.

"Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners of Dorchester county are hereby authorized and directed to do all things and to make all necessary arrangements to carry out the provisions of this Act."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time.
